
TT 54 Chair

Simple yet distinctive – typical Schneider-Esleben. In 1954 the German architect designed a dining room chair made of cane mesh and 12 mm roand steel, a work whose distinctive shape bequeaths it a high recognition value. The chair was launched to an international public in 1957 at the XI Triennale in Milan.
